Global Perspectives on Multilingualism in (Mental) Healthcare

Due to international and internal migration as well as local ethnic diversity most societies worldwide have a wealth of different languages at their disposal.

Patients who do not speak the same language as their health care provider are significantly disadvantaged in access to health care services and in securing adequate treatment quality. Health care providers often rely on family members or cleaning staff as interpreters or depend on machine translation.

Despite these challenges for patients as well as health care providers, most health institutions and health care systems lack standardized approaches to interpreting services, multilingual orientation, or policies that address linguistic diversity comprehensively.

By linking research, and clinical experience, the conference intends to develop strategies to improve health equity and strengthen global health systems.
